## **FURTHER REGULATIONS NAVIGATION ASSEMBLY**

*Issued 28 April 2023*

### **1. 5KM ODOMETER CHECK**

SR 1.8 refers: A 5km Odometer Check (set on the Riverina Highway close to Albury City) is attached to the Guide to the Event. Copies will also be available at Documentation on Thursday 4 May.

### **2. START ORDER**

SR 2.5 refers: The start order for each day will be as determined by the organisers and will be an amalgamation of the three Categories (Navigation Assembly, Social, Observation Touring) with one vehicle from each Category listed in turn, eg:

1. Navigation
  2. Social
  3. Observation Touring
  4. Navigation
  5. Social
  6. Observation Touring
- etc

Crews will assemble at the assembly location in Hovell Tree Park 30 minutes prior to the time of departure and leave at one minute intervals. Details are specified in the Guide to the Event.

A 'Report Time and Start Time' document will be issued with the road book and road card each day.

### **3. EVENT SCHEDULE**

SR4 refers: The event schedule has been amended and is now outlined in the Guide to the Event.

### **4. ROUTE INSTRUCTIONS**

SR 6.1 refers: Instructions for day start to lunch will be issued 10 minutes before the due start time each morning; instructions for lunch to day finish will be issued on arrival at the lunch breaks.

### **5. LICENCES**

SR 2.2 is amended to include the following. If a crew member is not a holder of a MA licence the organisers will arrange for the issue of a One Event Licence (cost \$25) subject to receiving the relevant completed licence application form (available from the organisers), NO LATER than the close of entries on Thursday 4 May.'

**6. CONTROL & COURSE MARKERS**

NTSR (NA) 5.1 c (i) Is amended such that a Red Clock board will be used instead of an 'M' board.
